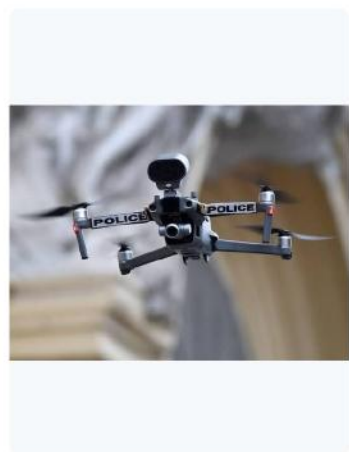

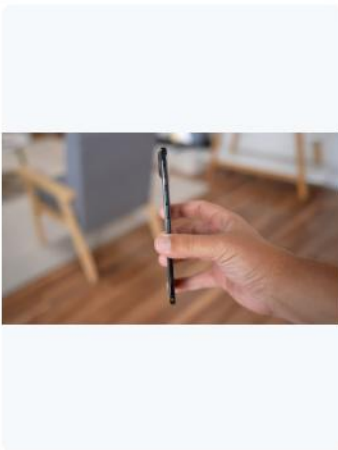

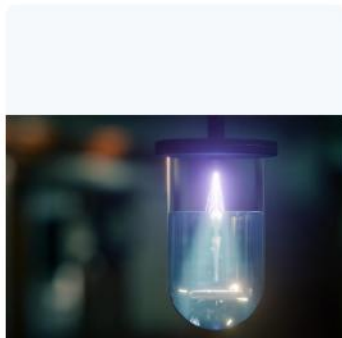
Scientists Find Signal to Forecast Solar Cycle Strength

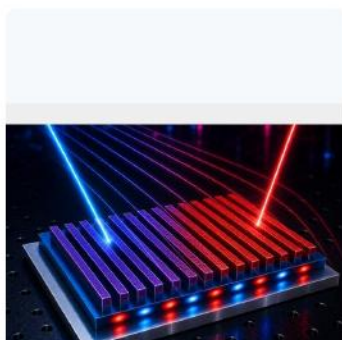

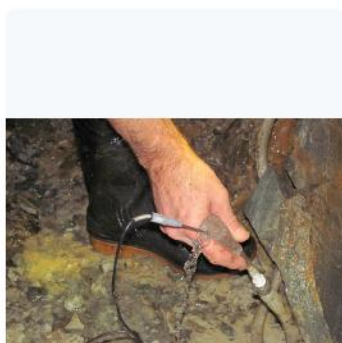

A 22 year old University of Plymouth student has developed an affordable device that can translate speech and display the text directly in front of a user's eyes. Designed over six months as part of her electrical and electronic engineering degree, the device costs about £30 to produce and uses affordable and recycled materials. A small clip on unit attaches to glasses and captures speech through a microphone.
